

PAPER

- **newspaper and magazines**
- **cup sleeves**
(paper/cardboard)
- **clean corrugated cardboard**
- **boxboard**
(cereal, tissue boxes)
- **fine paper**
- **flyers and catalogues**
- **card and cover stock**
- **envelopes and file folders**



RECYCLING

- **plastics materials, including:**
 - > plastic bottles, jugs and jars
 - > clear plastic containers
 - > plastic made of the following materials: 1(PETE), 2(HDPE) and 5(PP)
- **aluminum and metal cans**
- **milk cartons and juice boxes**
- **clear and coloured glass bottles**



ORGANIC

- **food products, such as:**
 - > dairy and eggshells
 - > fruits and vegetables
 - > grain products
 - > meat, fish and bones
- **tea bags, coffee grounds and filters**
- **houseplants**
- **other foods such as:**
 - > candy
 - > cookies



GARBAGE

- **biodegradable and compostable containers**
- **masks, gloves and face shields beverage cups**
- **condiment packages**
- **food packaging**
(chip bags, wrappers, etc.)
- **aluminium foil and cling wrap**
- **plastic bags**
- **greasy, oily and food stained boxes/wrappers**
- **grease proof containers**
(fry and burger containers, etc.)
- **black plastic, Styrofoam and utensils**
- **waxed cardboard**
- **sanitary products**
(baby wipes, cotton balls, ear cleaners, make-up removal pads)
- **cigarette butts**
- **corks**
- **disposable mop sheets**
- **dryer lint or sheets**
- **gum**
- **wax paper**
- **vacuum bags and contents**
- **padded envelopes**



Flatten all cardboard boxes.
